## Dear Partners,

The authorities of the Wroclaw Medical University, in connection with the ongoing epidemic related to COVID 19, inform that:

1. Student internships provided for the summer period (July - September) under the Erasmus + program in the 2019/2020 academic year will not take place due to the suspension of practical classes for students in hospital wards.

## 2. With regards to academic year 2020/21

All actions are taken on the part of the university authorities and hospital authorities so that classes for all students, including students from partner universities studying under the Erasmus + program, start on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020. Due to the dynamics of pandemic development, it is currently difficult to predict whether the classes will be conducted in the traditional system (lectures, seminars and clinical classes). Depending on the development of the situation, it may be necessary to start teaching in the new academic year only on-line. Nevertheless, actions will be taken to make up for clinical classes to achieve the assumed number of ECTS for individual subjects.

3. For Erasmus students who plan to come only for one semester as part of the SMS (study) or SMP (apprenticeship) mobility, we suggest arriving in the summer semester of the 2020/2021 academic year. This gives you a better chance of completing clinical classes.

Dear Partners, the authorities of our university would like to assure you of their priority activities aimed at maintaining all mobility under the Erasmus + program with all our partner universities, but it is currently difficult to predict 100% the direction of development of the pandemic. At the same time, the university must operate on the basis of current provisions and ordinances received on an ongoing basis from the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Science and Higher Education.

We will keep you and your students nominated to our university informed about the current didactic situation in the COVID 19 pandemic, which is so difficult for all.
