Academic Information	
<b>Academic Calendar</b>	The Academic Year is divided into two semesters:  - <b>Winter Semester:</b> (mid-September / end-February) - <b>Spring Semester:</b> (mid-February / end-July)  - <b>First semester exams</b> will take place in January and February. - <b>Second semester exams</b> will take place in June and July.



<b>Academic Calendar</b>	<b>IMPORTANT:</b> It is <b>NOT POSSIBLE</b> to take second semester/annual exams in January/February. It is only possible to take an exam if the student has followed the course!  The <b>last chance</b> to take an exam is in September.
<b>Credit System</b>	CFU - Crediti Formativi Universitari (Local Credits)  1 CFU = 1 ECTS
<b>Grading System</b>	The Italian Grading System ranges from 18/30 to 30/30.  The highest mark is 30/30 with distinction (lode).  Exams under 18/30 are considered as “fail/not passed”. Certain laboratories and internships may report “Idoneo/Non Idoneo” or “Pass/Fail”, NO GRADE.
<b>Linguistic requirements</b>	To be accepted at the University of Florence, students must possess a <b>B1 Italian language certificate</b> (B2 is recommended for those who will undertake internships). <u>We will accept Italian B1-level language certifications issued by:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Recognized Italian language schools</li><li>• University Language Centers</li><li>• Home Universities (via official declarations)</li><li>• High school diplomas from bilingual schools where Italian is one of the languages.</li></ul> The language certificate must be submitted by the application deadline (see details below).
<b>Linguistic Center (Centro Linguistico di Ateneo - CLA)</b>	Students can attend courses of languages at the University Linguistic Center - CLA: <a href="http://www.cla.unifi.it">www.cla.unifi.it</a>  The first Italian course is free of charge for Erasmus/Exchange students.  Preliminary enrolment for Italian language courses can be done online. Students must fill in the application form on the CLA website. All other application documents (learning agreement, identity card, enrollment form, and transcript of records) must be submitted by 15th June.</i></p>



<b>Learning Agreement</b>	<p>The Learning Agreement should be delivered through <b>EWP</b> if the host <u>University is connected with this new system.</u></p> <p>Otherwise, the Pdf form must be sent via email together with the other documents.</p>
<b>Changes to the Learning Agreement</b>	<p>Erasmus students are allowed to change their learning agreement only <b>once per semester</b> with the following deadlines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>15th November</b> for changes of the first semester or whole year subjects or clinical rotations.</li><li>• <b>15th March</b> for changes of the second semester subjects or clinical rotations.</li></ul>
<b>Transcript of Records/Certificate of Attendance</b>	<p>At the end of the students' mobility period, the International Relations Office sends the official Transcript of Records and certificate of Attendance by email directly to the Home University/Coordinator.</p> <p><b>ONLY Digital Documents are available</b></p> <p><b>The Certification of Stay issued upon arrival and departure is in Unifi format.</b></p> <p><b>No other form or declaration will be signed.</b></p>
