We are writing to update you on recent developments at our university related to the COVID-19 pandemic and how they will affect student mobilities in the upcoming winter term (2021/22).

After carefully considering alternative scenarios, the Medical University of Vienna has decided to further extend the cancellation of all exchange activities, both incoming and outgoing, to the winter term 2021/22.

Subject to further developments in the COVID-19 crisis we are planning to resume student mobilities in the summer term of 2022.

Our International Office will shortly provide you with details on the new nomination / application timeline and process for incoming mobilities in the 2022 summer term. The previously communicated deadline in April 2021 exceptionally has been suspended.

Accordingly, we will send you our own nominations only for the 2022 summer term.
