

Dear partner,

We hope this email finds you well.

Here I send you relevant information for your students coming to Universidad Complutense of Madrid for the next academic year 2021/2022. We have been working together with our associated hospitals to offer the best possible academic plan for incoming students next year taking into account the circumstances we are facing. Based on this, our School has taken the following decisions for 2021/2022:

1. Incoming students will be able to take **any of the offered subjects as before the pandemic**. They can be found at: <https://medicina.ucm.es/guias-docentes>
2. Regarding clinical rotations, due to the limitations in clinical placements caused by the pandemic, our hospitals have informed us that incoming students will be able to do clinical rotations with the following conditions:
 - A **maximum of two clinical rotations** (around 4 weeks each) per student will be offered for the academic year 2021/2022.
 - **Clinical rotations will be available only for students involved in Erasmus+ Studies**, but not for those applying for an Erasmus Traineeship.
 - Students must present a **COVID19 vaccination certificate in advance**.
 - **Our office will contact** the students to require them information regarding which are the clinical services of choice. So **this information does not need to be included** in the application platform (MoveOn).

We will be pleased if you could forward this information to your nominated students coming to our University in Madrid next academic year.
