



Faculté de médecine LYON EST

At the Faculty of medicine Lyon EST, ERASMUS and exchange students' education alternates between 6 weeks of classes and 6 weeks of internships in different hospitals, members of the Hospices Civils de Lyon, in various departments (see p.4).

Students can pick courses from 4th (DFASM1) and 5th (DFASM2) year (listed p.2-3)

Theoretical courses

• All courses are taught in french, so students are required to have at least a B2 CECRL level.

French intensive courses can be given in late august during one week (3 ECTS) or throughout the year, every thursday night (3 ECTS)

• Students can attend courses from **both 4th and 5th year** of medicine studies.

Students have access to their schedule once they are fully registered.

All informations regarding their education is published throughout the year on https://sides.uness.fr/.

For each year (4th and 5th), courses and practices are **divided into two groups**: Group 1 and Group 2. Both groups alternate between courses and traineeships. While Group 1 is practicing at the hospital, group 2 is following courses at the faculty, and conversely. Students can choose their group when applying.

Courses are divided into two kind of instruction:

- Enseignement Dirigé (ED): supervised teaching, in small groups of students (usually 35/group)
- Cours magistral (CM): Lecture course, with all students.

Students can choose one year or the other in **principal year of study**.

For example, if a student chooses the 4th year as principal year of study, but also chooses to pick some courses from the 5th year, they will have to participate in all of the CM chosen, but it will be mandatory for them to only go to their principal year's EDs.

Exams

There are two types of exams:

- Examen en contrôle continue (CCE): midterm exam (mandatory for all chosen courses).
- Contrôle Terminal: final exam (mandatory for all choses courses).

The grade obtained through the final exam counts for 2/3 of the final grade given to the student.

Traineeships

Exchange students, as well as local students, participate in 6 week full-time traineeships in different hospitals' departments (listed p.4).

When applying, students make 5 wishes of departments for each semester and the administration will assign them to departments according to the places available.

Please note that the Gynecology-Obstetrics and Pediatrics departments are often full, students are not guaranteed to secure their wish in those wards.

Once the assignments are made and sent to the students, no changes will be allowed or made.

Traineeships in the Hospices Civils de Lyon

When applying, ERASMUS and international students make a list of all the departments they're interested in, in terms of traineeships.

They can do **up to 3 traineeship of 6 weeks each**, per year. They can also attend to a 4th optional traineeship that'll last 8 weeks.

These traineeships take place during specific periods (see enclosed).

As for next year 2022/2023, students from **group** 1 will start the **first semester with courses**, and students from **group** 2 will start the **first semester with a 6 week traineeship**.

Rotating with the 6 weeks periods of courses*:

1 validated traineeship = 10 ECTS

A1 - AUTOMNE 1: from 13/09 to 22/10/21 **A2 - AUTOMNE 2:** from 25/10 to 03/12/21

H1 - HIVER 1: from 06/12/21 to 14/01/22 **H2 - HIVER 2:** from 17/01/22 to 25/02/22

P1 - PRINTEMPS 1: from 28/02 to 08/04/22 **P2 - PRINTEMPS 2**: from 11/04 to 20/05/22

Optional 8 weeks traineeship, if wanted (12 ECTS):

E1 - ETE 1: from 23/05 to 15/07/22 **E2 - ETE 2:** from 18/07 to 09/09/22

*Yet to define for 2022/2023

The administration assigns students according to the list established by the students when applying.

As soon as assigned, students can contact the head of hospital service and their secretary to get informations related to the schedule or equipment to bring.

At the end of each traineeship, the student gets delivered an **evaluation form**, allowing us to know **whether the traineeship has been validated or not**.

If validated, the student gets 10 ECTS more in his Transcript of records.
