	Thursday	Salutogenesis and Healthy Lifestyles - Prescription of health assets to change behaviours and attitudes in individuals, families and communities.
	Friday	Practical session with Clinical Simulation in the community context and its application to specific situations (obesity, diabetes, chronic pathologies, etc).
Online	September 4th-11th-18th	Students do a mapping of health assets in a specific area (village, neighborhood,etc.), applying all the knowledge and competences acquired
